

A Short break to Mussoorie: 02 nights/ 03 days

Mussoorie, the proverbial Queen of Hill stations, with its green hills and varied flora and fauna, is a fascinating hill resort. Spread over a ridge, 2000 meters above sea level, Mussoorie offers distant views of the holy and mighty river Ganga from one end of the ridge, and of the famous river Jamuna from the other. An idyllic stroll through any of the meandering mountain roads of the town, on a clear and sunny day will bring you to Landour Bazaar, Chaar dukaan, Lal Tibba, Gun Hill, the Camel Back cemetery and the Mussoorie Library. Apart from its own quiet charm, Mussoorie also boasts of spectacular views of the Himalayas.

The hill station of Mussoorie also serves as the gateway to the shrines of Yamunotri, Gangotri, Kedarnath and Badrinath that make up the Char Dham Yatra. Close by are popular picnic spots like Kempty Falls in the west and Dhanolti, further up beyond the town.

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Itinerary:

Day 01: Pick up from Delhi, drive to Mussoorie

The TDI car will pick you up from the airport or railway station or even from your home for your tour to Mussoorie. The route takes you through the cities of Meerut, Muzaffarnagar and Dehradun. For lunch you may take a break at one of the local restaurants en route (own expense).

Upon arrival, check- into the resort and spend the evening at leisure. Take a stroll on the Mall road to soak in the atmosphere.

Have a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel. Dinner is at the hotel.

Day 02: Spend a day in Mussoorie

After breakfast the day will be spent doing Local Sightseeing in and around Mussoorie.

Visit Lal tibba, Gun hill, the Camel Back cemetery and the Mussoorie Library.

You may also like to visit Kempty Fall (15 Km).

Spend the evening at leisure followed by dinner and stay overnight at the hotel.

Day 03: Drive back to Delhi

After breakfast, depart for Delhi for your flight/train to your onward destination. Enroute you may visit the Rajaji National Park as well.
